The PLAY Project license provides benefits to both the organization and the individual professional, as detailed below.

Permission to use PLAY Project Name

The PLAY Project name has received formal trademark registration from the US Patent & Trademark Office. Professionals and organizations who implement the PLAY Project autism intervention model have permission to use our name, logo, and program materials under our license agreement.
