IMPLEMENTATION COURSE

During our award-winning asynchronous Implementation Course, participants learn how to master the 7 Circles of the PLAY Project in order to develop the skills needed to: 1.) Effectively coach parents and caretakers to playfully engage with their child with autism or other developmental delays;

2.) Confidently implement PLAY methods and techniques in a home or clinic setting; and
3.) Document the child's developmental progress. After completing the online course, the professional is officially a "Certified PLAY Project Consultant in training" and can begin consulting with families.

The time from workshop to on-line course to working with families can be as short as 2-3 months! This course is designed for working professionals.
