



PLAY PROJECT RE-ACTIVATION POLICY

A Certified PLAY Project Consultant or Teaching PLAY Consultant can become inactive in two different ways. 1. Their license is inactive or void due to failure to pay licensing fee or failure to comply with Appendix A in License Agreement. 2. Failure to comply with Re-Certification policy.

The following steps must be completed before an individual can become a Certified PLAY Project Consultant or Teaching PLAY Consultant.

1 Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Submit 1 case for Supervision	\$59
2 Years	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Submit 2 cases for Supervision	\$109
3 Years	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 6-week online Certification course• 5 online exams• 3 cases for supervision	\$659
5 Years	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Intensive Workshop• 6-week online Certification Course• 5 online exam• 5 cases for supervision	\$859

In addition, a License Agreement and fee would be required to offer PLAY Project Services.
