Since then, she has been providing training and educational consultation to parents of children with developmental challenges and conducting professional training both nationally and internationally. Mónica has also served as PLAY Project Supervisor to newly trained PLAY Project Consultants for the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) and continues to provide training and supervision to other professionals through Relate & Grow, the PLAY Project organization, ICDL (the Interdisciplinary Council for Development and Learning), Profectum, and the PLAY Project Center at the Childhood League Center.
