



## PLAY Project Supervision Task Guidelines

Our guidelines are designed to encourage continuous engagement and professional development among PPCs in training. By offering case submission suggestions, the PLAY Project ensures that all PPCs have the opportunity to deliver services with the highest level of competence and adherence to the PLAY Project's evidence-based model within a timely fashion.

Throughout Supervision, you will complete 12 Supervision tasks including the following:

- 4 Online Case submissions
- 5 Individual Mentoring Sessions
- 1 Group case presentation
- 2 Group Case Presentation attendee

Please reference the Certification Training Guide for specific instructions on how to complete the Supervision tasks. Your 12<sup>th</sup> task MUST be an Online Case Submission to the Training Director. We highly recommend starting with an Online Case Submission and saving the Group Case Presentation for a later task (10 or 11).

These Supervision Task guidelines reflect the expectations outlined in the chart below, ensuring timely progression through the case submission process.

### **Suggested PLAY Supervision Task Guidelines:**

Months after completing Implementation Course	Number of Supervision Tasks Completed
3 months	1-2 Supervision Tasks
6 months	4-6 Supervision Tasks
9 months	9-10 Supervision Tasks
12 months	12 Supervision Tasks

The assigned Supervision Deadline will be 18 months from the end of the Implementation Course, however, we strongly recommend that you try and complete at least 1 task/month. Ideally, most trainees will complete the 12 Supervision Tasks within a 12 month period (or less).
